Cheerleading is the newest "full recognition" Olympic sport, and with around 90,000 UK cheerleaders currently, makes it the fastest growing sport - a record it has held for many years. Fast paced acrobatic stunting, gymnastic floor tumbling, dance, and a heavy emphasis on performance makes Cheerleading a truly unique sport.



What are we looking for in an International Athlete?

As with all our team placements, we are looking to place athletes on these teams who:

- Have a good history of "coachability". Trying new things, working hard outside of practice, being positive in training, listening to their coaches and applying corrections first time, giving 100% to whatever they're trying are all essential components of being a part of an International Team. All athletes must additionally be prepared to accept any stunting position given on any team we are cheerleaders first, and flyers/bases second. Being coachable is the MAIN focus for placing our International Travel Teams.
- Have an impeccable history of attendance, punctuality, and a consistent financial record with no arrears on their account.
- Are excellent team-mates both on and off the mat. International athletes will be expected to spend a lot of time together whilst abroad and we have zero tolerance on bullying, forming cliques, and excluding athletes from daily activities whilst in a different country.
- Have a complete respect of the knowledge that they are representing White Rose
 Cheer and the UK and will do so with great sportsmanlike conduct.
- Have the strongest skills possible in both stunting AND tumbling for the level of the team.

We naturally want to field the strongest routines possible for our chosen levels and age groups. We want the greatest chance at success – in all ways. It's not the 2.5 minutes on the mat that makes a trip successful – we want the athletes to create wonderful memories with their teammates and have a real learning experience.

Athletes are permitted to attend more than one international trip, including attending multiple Orlando Worlds Events – please bear in mind the extra commitment and cost. You will have the option to indicate this on your Placement Form.



All Monthly Fees are paid across 12 months, beginning in August 2025 and concluding in July 2026. It is an entire season charge split equally over 12 months and considers gym closures within the fee calculations. All competition, music and choreography costs are provisional until providers can confirm their final costs.

Trip Policies for 2026

- All cheerleading commitments, whether training, competitions, team bonding or otherwise, takes precedence over all leisure activities. Please do not book anything non-refundable.
- Families are welcome to join us on the trip. All athletes 12 and under will be required to attend with at least one parent. All adult athletes will be expected to travel and stay alone.
- All athletes are expected to travel and stay with the group, no exceptions. Wherever possible we will attempt to group families/athletes together where we know natural friendships lie. Athletes aged 13 or over will be permitted to travel alone without their parents and will be chaperoned by nominated WRC Staff and Parents.
- All athletes will be required to be at daytime training in the UK any time between Saturday 4th Friday 10th April, with the final UK competition being 11-12th April before our first leg (ASW) commences. Athletes who are not flying out until later are welcome to go on holiday in the second week of the school Easter holidays, commencing 13th April. Every effort will be made for additional training to not impact the main Easter Bank Holiday weekend, from Friday 3rd- Monday 6th April. To be included in our final competitions of the year, all athletes must have returned by the time the Summit trip ends. Any Florida trip extensions must be within these guidelines.
- Parents/family members are welcome to travel to Florida and stay independently of the group, away from their athlete who will be staying in club villas. We would love to have you join us on competition days and celebration evenings.
- All payments must be made promptly and without delay these are not our deadlines!
